“5” Hour ERS Trainings:

This is a mandatory requirement for 1st time RCCCC CARES/AB 212 Stipend Program participants, it is an optional choice for returning participants who wish to update scoring skills or train on a new scale due to classroom changes. All CARES/AB 212 Stipend Program participants attending a 5 hour ERS training must submit all required documentation to the RCCCC office within *30 calendar days from the date of this training*.

“Review” ERS Training:

This training meets the mandatory training requirements for returning RCCCC CARES/AB 212 Stipend Program participants who have previously taken a 5 hour ERS training with an approved RCCCC trainer to raise a low Item score on their previous ERS Score Sheet. All CARES/AB 212 participants must evaluate their classroom after taking a “Review” training and complete an ERS Score Sheet and Needs Improvement Plan.
